Rule 15 Shall read. The surfing season shall be from the first day of October in one year to the first Sunday after Easter in the next subsequent year.

Rule 17 Clause (a) shall read.

All active Members shall perform a test swim of two hundred yards or more within a time limit to be fixed by the Committee, between the first Wednesday of September and the 31st December in each year. A member must complete at least ~~three surf races in each season~~. Any member failing to perform such tests or to furnish a satisfactory explanation as to his failure shall be liable to be declared ineligible to be an Active Member of the Club.
