I present to you a brief Report of the Club's activities for the 1941-1942 season.

LIFE SAVING:

Although the activities of the Club began to cease early in February, and many Members were called up for the services, Patrols had been maintained with a great deal of efficiency, but activities were shortened owing to shortage of transport and very little public attendance at the beach. 20 Rescues were performed in the early part of the season both with and without the belt.
